## **DIRECTIONS To November meeting**

Craig Engwall cabin phone number is 218-659-4695. Directions are as follows:

From Grand Rapids:

Continue west on US Hwy. 2 through Deer River, then turn right (north) on MN Hwy. 46 just after the White Oak Casino.

Stay on Hwy. 46 until mile marker 20, then turn right on County Road 34 (Max Road).

Continue straight on the Max Road for 7.3 miles, then turn left on County Road 126 (which is gravel).

Stay on County Road 126 for 3.6 miles, then turn right on County Road 145.

Continue on County Road 145 (which winds around quite a bit) for 3.3 miles, and as you come over a little hill, my cabin road is on the left. I'll have some sort of sign there; it is also a U.S. Forest Service Road (2293).

Go straight down the bumpy road about one mile. My cabin is at the end with a house number of 56700.

From Northome:

Go south on MN Hwy. 46 about 9 miles, then turn left (east) on County Road 29 (Dora Lake Road).

Continue 11.3 miles, then turn right on County Road 145. After you turn, continue 0.7 miles. You'll drive through the tiny town of Dora Lake, past the Kinghurst Town Hall, the Alliance Church, etc. After a sharp left curve just past the Alliance Church, take a right to stay on County Road 145. It now becomes a gravel road instead of paved.

Proceed about 0.5 miles, and my cabin road will be on the right. I'll have some sort of sign there; it is also a U.S. Forest Service Road (2293).

Go straight down the bumpy road about one mile. My cabin is at the end with a house number of 56700.

From Big Falls:

Go south on MN Hwy 6 about 30 miles or so. As you pass the turn off to Bigfork, continue straight for 0.9 miles, then turn right on County Road 14. Keep going on County Road 14 for 9.8 miles until you come to a T, then turn right on County Road 29. Proceed on County Road 29 for 5.2 miles, then turn left on County Road 145. After you turn, continue 0.7 miles. You'll drive through the tiny town of Dora Lake, past the Kinghurst Town Hall, the Alliance Church, etc. After a sharp left curve just past the Alliance Church, take a right to stay on County Road 145. It now becomes a gravel road instead of paved.

Proceed about 0.5 miles, and my cabin road will be on the right. I'll have some sort of sign there; it is also a U.S. Forest Service Road (2293).
